Position Purpose

The Red Nose Educator reports to the Education Manager. As part of the Red Nose Education Services team the primary focus of this position is to deliver the Red Nose messages to a broad range of audiences. This will include delivering educational presentations aligned with Red Nose's evidence-based education around reducing the risk of sudden unexpected death of infants (SUDI). The Red Nose Educator will be required to present Red Nose educational material to groups such as early childhood educators, health professionals, parents, etc. and support other Red Nose activities such as Exhibitions and Red Nose Day activities with the aim of driving the Red Nose messages to as many people as possible. Shifts will vary but mostly be after hours. Travel outside of major cities, to regional areas may be required of this position. The incumbent must have access to their own car.
